Dear sisters and brothers in Christ,

"Behold, I am making all things new."

These words, from the last book of sacred scripture, are of singular significance as we embark upon our life together at the beginning of a new year. They comprise a solid, never-changing promise to serve as the bedrock for meeting the challenges that lie ahead for our parish in this topsy-turvy, ever-changing world.

In recent months, your parish council(s) have begun to identify some of those challenges, among which are: the changing demography of the rural area, declining membership and church attendance, aging membership and concern about the scarcity of young people and young families, financial pressures, frenzied personal and family schedules, and aging populations. Most of you are aware of the story. And in the mix of all these concerns is an aggressive secularism that is indifferent, even hostile, to the Christian faith and the church.

I, with your elected parish leaders, are concerned about the future of the parish we all know and love. But let's be clear... We have a Lord who has given us a singular promise that creates faith and give us way to a firmness of conviction.

Yes...We are bound and determined to build upon the legacy of faith and stalwart commitment that has been bequeathed to us. We make it our aim to pass the same on to those who come after us. We are a gritty bunch disciples of Christ.

But we will do well to remember this:

"Faith is not a thought, although thinking follows from it; it is not a feeling, though the feeling of comfort emerges from it; neither is faith a virtue or a moral act. Faith is not glory; it gives no power in the world, it guarantees no success or relief from suffering—indeed suffering increases with faith. What faith does, however, is give unshakeable certainty, the very kind that human works fruitlessly seek, since they place trust in something other than Christ's promise of the forgiveness of sins. All else in life fails to bring peace or release from anxiety and uncertainty because everything ("when all supports are washed away....") besides Christ's promise is in the process of being destroyed by God." (Steven D. Paulson, Lutheran Theology)

So, here at the end, as it was in the beginning, is the key to the future of this parish. Begin anywhere, or with anything else, and we are doomed to endless anxiety and certain failure. So here it is. One little word. And there's our future!!!
