Pastor's Page

Dear sisters and brothers in Christ,

I have to admit. Listening to hymns in worship is no match to singing them. To put it bluntly, I am missing the freedom to sing the hymns in full-throated voice. Make no mistake. Christian hymnody gives profound and joyful expression to hearts uplifted by the Good News. But the hymns also are a great medium for the articulation and teaching of the Christian faith. And that is what I want you think about with me.

You may have noticed that the second lessons of recent Sunday worship services come from the book of Philippians. On Sunday, September 27th, one of the oldest Christian hymns was read.

Have this mind among yourselves, which is yours in Christ

Jesus, who, though he was in the form of God, did not count equality with God a thing to be grasped. but made himself nothing, taking the form of a servant, being born in the likeness of men.

And being found in human form, he humbled himself by becoming obedient unto death, even death on a cross.

Therefore God has highly exalted him and bestowed on him the name that is above every name, so that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth, and every tongue confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father. (Philippians 2.5-11).

This is no squishy hymn. It is angular. It has sharp corners. It is not sentimental. This hymn is theological and cosmic. It proclaims our Christ. He is not a life-coach. He is not a fine moral teacher. He is the Son of God. He is the one in whom, and through whom "God so loved the world."

There's not a word about us nothing--- save the inferred fact that in and through his death on the cross he has saved and redeemed a people (yes, you and me! us!) whose proper response is nothing other than to humbly confess and give thanks that he is Lord "to the glory of God the Father."

In Christian hymnody "worth its salt", we call that "doxology". And doxology is best when it's sung. So, here are the words to such a hymn:

Praise God from whom all blessing flow;

Praise him, all creatures here below;

Praise him above ye heav'nly host;

Praise Father, Son, and Holy Ghost.

Now sing it out loud in full-throated voice! And Covid19 be damned!
