Bath sized bars (4 to 5 oz.) with wrapping, only new bars of any brand.

BABY CARE KITS

Two lightweight cotton T-shirts (no onesies)

Two long or short sleeved gowns for sleepers (without feet)

Two receiving blankets, medium weight cotton or flannel up to 52"

Four cloth diapers flat fold preferred

One jacket, sweater or sweatshirt with a hood or include a baby cap

One pair of socks

One hand towel, dark color recommended

Two bath size bars (4 to 5 0z. of gentle soap in original wrapping

Two diaper pins or large safety pins

SCHOOL KITS

Four 70 sheet notebooks (280-300 sheets total) or wide or college ruled paper - no loose leaf paper

One 30 centimeter ruler or a ruler with centimeters on one side and inches on the other
