Dear Church-

It may be a bit weird-but this is my favorite time of year.

No not the cold weather, and the snow and the shorter days. But this church season we are entering now...Advent! I love Advent.

And in this time of year, I can pretty easily get on my soapbox when we skip from Halloween right to Christmas. Every time I have walked through Menard's in the past couple of months to see all of the Christmas inflatables up for sale, next to the ones for Halloween and Thanksgiving, I scoff a little and roll my eyes. "It isn't even November yet" (ok...it is now) I would think.

And I love Advent, because rather than jumping from holiday to holiday, from celebration to celebration, Advent asks us to acknowledge the challenge that is waiting. Advent asks us to acknowledge the "not yets" of the world. I find peace in knowing a faith that is present both in the celebration and in the waiting, the known and the unknown, the now and not yet.

Dear ones, to me it feels like we are in the middle of long Advent as a church- the middle of celebrating and waiting, the known and the unknown, the now and not yet.

We are in the celebration of life returning to "normal" post-COVID but the waiting to see what our "new normal" will be. We are in the knowing that we have a strong faith community but the unknown of what that will continue to look like. We are in the now of my being your interim pastor but the "not-yet" of a permanent call.

We are in our own Advent time as a church. So perhaps this year more than any other, it is important to slow down right now and sit in the Advent-time and to remember God's presence in the middle of the waiting, unknowing and the not-yets.

I have a dear friend and mentor who's favorite day of the year is December 21st, the shortest day, the winter solstice. I thought it was odd when she shared this with me but then she explained that, encountering the shortest day, or put another way, the longest night, meant that the days were going to slowly start getting longer. That slowly there would be more light each day and each day would get brighter and brighter.

This is the promise of Advent as well. That the celebration will happen, the waiting will end, we will step into a greater known and our new "now".

As we find ourselves, unable to avoid the "Advent" time in our live, the waiting and the unknown, we also are people who trust this Advent promise is still present. That God's hope is not just present in the celebration of Christmas but in the waiting, in the promise that God's light comes into our world in unexpected ways.

We will get through this time of waiting. The days will start getting brighter. It may be a slow process and it won't happen all at once, but we will get there. We will get to the celebration of Christ's coming at Christmas, even if it looks a little different than expected.

That is the promise of Advent.
