Transfiguration of Our Lord

On Sunday, February 23rd, the church observes the feast of the Transfiguration of Our Lord. The episode is unanimously attested by the gospels, Matthew, Mark, and Luke. There are two essential elements: 1) Jesus leads the disciples Peter, James, and John up a high mountain and there he was transfigured before them and his face and his garments shone with dazzling light while Moses and Elijah appeared beside him; 2) a cloud overshadowed the mountain peak and from it came a voice saying, "This is my beloved Son, with whom I am well pleased; listen to him" (Matthew 17.1-9). By now Jesus is oriented to fulfilling his mission. He knows that he must pass through the Passion and death on a Cross before being raised from the dead. He, therefore, wants his disciples to glimpse his divine glory so that his light will illuminate their hearts when they pass through the thick darkness of his Passion and death, the foolishness of the Cross, and following him becomes unbearable to them. His light is the light we all need to overcome the trials of life. And he, our Christ, gives it to us to save us.

Ash Wednesday

Both congregations of the parish will observe Ash Wednesday on February 26th (see the schedule on the previous pages). The day marks the beginning of the Season of Lent. It is a season of repentance, prayers, and reflection which prepares us for Christ's holy passion and resurrection. During the Holy Communion you will be invited to have ashes imposed on your forehead. Ashes are a symbol of penance and contrition. We remember that God is gracious and merciful while these words are addressed to each one of us: "Remember that you are dust, and to dust you shall return". You are encouraged to journey through Lent in the worshiping fellowship of the parish community of faith.

Lenten Midweek Learning and Prayer 2020

Theme for this year's Wednesday, Lenten mid-week worship gathering will be Life in Christ: Our Path Through Calvary. Each Wednesday will be a time of intergenerational learning and conversation about the real struggles of life in the faith. What do our struggles tell us about faith? What do they tell about our faith? If one struggles, does it identify the poor, the feeble, the failure in faith? Is there anything redeeming about our struggles? How might we live through the struggles? Is there any end to **our** struggles? How does the Spirit help us? Pastor's Page, February 2020

"The Word Made Flesh ... Continued"

As have moved through the seasons of Advent, Christmas, Epiphany, and now prepare to enter the season of Lent, I humbly ask you to consider/reconsider what the fact of God's incarnation means.

The Word became flesh. Jesus Christ took on everything that our flesh is heir to; all our weakness, all our sorrow, all our sickness and brokenness, all of our god-forsakenness, he took to himself.

Christ did this not merely because "misery loves company." He took it all to himself to overcome it. He goes to the cross as flesh, and rises as Spirit. He took on our flesh in order to fill us with the power of the Spirit of divine love and mercy.

Ah...but we still live in the flesh; we still find ourselves broken, sorrowful, anxious, fearful, weak, and shattered. Jesus died and rose not so we could be rid of our fleshliness, but that it could be transformed from within by the Spirit, so that our weakness could be the manifestation of strength, brokenness could be the manifestation of wholeness, and forsakenness the manifestation of intimacy.

When Christ cried out from the cross, "My God, my God, why have you forsaken me," this strength in weakness, this wholeness in brokenness, this intimacy in godforsakenness, was revealed as True Love in the flesh. It was (He was and is!) "for us and for our salvation." And God raised him from the dead in order that we might be transformed----with all those he has chosen, "fleshy" as we are—into persons who, Spirit-filled, are made holy.

"If anyone is in Christ, he/she is a new creation.

The old has passed away; behold, the new has come. All this is from God, who through Christ reconciled us to himself and gave us the ministry of reconciliation; that is, in Christ God was reconciling the world to himself, not counting their trespasses against them, and entrusting to us the message of reconciliation. Therefore we are ambassadors for Christ, God making his appeal through us.....For our sake (God) made him (Jesus) to be sin who knew no sin, that in him we might become the righteousness of God."

(2 Corinthians 5.17-21).

There you have it. God made flesh, Jesus Christ, and in whose Spirit in we may live anew!
