When the three women arrived at the tomb of Jesus in the early morning hours after the Sabbath to finish anointing his body they did not expect to find the tomb empty. Taking care of their dear teacher's body was to have been the last loving task they would do for him and now the tomb was empty. This was far more than annoying. IT WAS HORRIFYING.

Who would steal his body? Why would they steal it? What were they doing to his body?

The women had come to honor Jesus life and ministry by caring for his human body and now they feared it was being desecrated by some unknown villain. And yet, as horrified as they were, they listened to the glowing strangers who suddenly appeared at Jesus' empty tomb. The men who said, *Jesus is not here, he has been raised up*. 
