#### Pastor's Page

Dear sisters and brothers in Christ,

One of my favorite hymn writers is Christina Rossetti. Although less known as a hymn writer than as a poet, she penned two of the most sublime and beautiful hymn texts of the Christmas season. In "In the Bleak Midwinter" she describes the emptiness of a world without Christ as a world "in the bleak midwinter". But, lo and behold, the great interrupting event of God comes, "whom heaven cannot hold, nor earth sustain." The Lord God comes incarnate in a baby boy child. His name is Jesus.

In another Christmas hymn, "Love Came Down at Christmas", Rossetti identifies "the Lord God incarnate", Jesus, as Love.

Love came down at Christmas, Love all lovely, Love Divine; Love was born at Christmas, Star and angel gave the sign.

Think on this. Love was born at Christmas. And mind you, this Love was not an idea among ideas. This Love was not a fleeting feeling or a passing fancy. This Love came in a world-shattering and life-transforming event ---the birth of the God-man--- "Love divine, all loves excelling"---who has arrived *in and for* this tired, old, sinful, and wintery world. And as the hymn text, true to Sacred Writ, tell us: "Star and angel gave the sign."

But you and I may well ask: "What sign do we have???" For we, unlike the unsuspecting shepherds" keeping watch over their flocks by night", have no angel host. We have no star like the one that lead curious wise men in their quest for the Savior of humankind. What sign comes to people, "like you and like I", caught up in the monotonous drone of the present day and its uncertainties and attending anxieties, doubts, fears, and griefs? Note Rossetti's second verse.

Worship we the Godhead, Love Incarnate, Love Divine; Worship we our Jesus: But wherewith for sacred sign?

"But wherewith for sacred sign?" That is the same sort of question that she asks in the carol, "In the Bleak Midwinter." "What can I give him?"

Our sign, born of the cheering news of that "Love came down", is the fellowship his coming to earth creates. It is the fellowship of men, women, and children who journey out into the darkness of "the bleak midwinter" to "the place of bread"--- that is, the Bethlehem of our locale---to adore and rejoice and be comforted by him...."Love Incarnate, Love Divine". That's our sign.

Love shall be our token,

Love be yours and love be mine,

Love to God and to all men,

Love for plea and gift and sign.

Ah yes. The gift of Love, Jesus, gives us the new life of loving God and each other. In the Bethlehem of our locale, we come to love and to adore God in the Christ child. We come and bend our knees and bow our heads in love and be transformed into new people in a world made new by Love to love---a world wherein all people to us are our sisters and brothers shepherds and stargazers on a journey to Love. We plead for Love, and we give love. And that love is itself the mighty star in the night of this dark, cold world. And that love is the angelic good tidings of great joy to world that needs it so badly! It is "Love for plea and gift and sign."
