




# **Highland Prairie**

### President Report

Pastor Jackie and I attended a Council As Leader's Conference put on by the Southeast MN Synod on March 8th in Owatonna, MN. The theme of the conference was POWER-the Holy Spirit calls us to have power to bear witness and proclaim God's Word and Works. The P -stands for Pray and the O- stands for Observe and the W -stands for witness and the E- stands for empower and the R- stands for reflect. We attended the first workshop on updating the Constitution and Bylaws and Continuing Resolutions. The second workshop was on Building a Connected Church: Strengthening Council and Congregation Relationships. Talking to other church councils, we are all having the same issues in church attendance, Sunday school attendance, money issues, and so on. We are not alone in solving these issues, Brothers and Sisters.

The HP council is busy working on various church items. HP must update our Constitution and Bylaws this year. We have formed a committee of Val H, Kristi G, Sharon B and Pastor Jackie to update the Constitution and Bylaws. In April, we will be reviewing church committees' duties and procedures. An ADA Evaluation of our church was completed by SEMCIL. Copies of the ADA evaluation report are in the Narthex if you want to review it. As a council we are processing and collecting more information on how to proceed with the ADA report. The church trim around the roof needs to be replaced or fixed and we discover we need a new roof (shingles are cracking) in one to two years so the council is collecting information on replacing the roof. We are still working out the kinks in the new church and financial software. Please have patience with this process. Thank God for what we have and trust and have faith in God for what we need.


