We are talking about a specific denomination of the Christian church. For those of you grammar love

<u>Time after Pentecost</u> Elstad—9:00 a.m. Highland Prairie—10:30 a.m.	In the creed, however, we are talking about "catholic," with a lower case 'c', which is the adjective version of "catholic." When we use "catholic" as an adjective, we are talking about the universality of something. We are not talking about a specific denomination but about the broad, inclusive, all embracing nature of the WHOLE of the catholic (with a lower case) church. We are talking about the way the church is made of many parts, many denominations, many individual beliefs and is still one church in our love and faithfulness to Christ.
