Maybe you know this feeling, maybe you know the feeling of the ever growing to-do list-whether it's kids or grandkids or house repairs or work-the feeling like it is never done is exhausting.

I can't make to- do lists disappear or life magically calmer...but I can offer you a space to come and sit, to breath and to just be.

Starting with our Ash Wednesday service on February 22nd, we are going to be doing some new things in worship.

On Wednesday nights, we will have "dinner church" with conversation prompts followed by a return to the familiar "Holden Evening Prayer" worship service.

On Sunday mornings, we are going to try to have a "Taize" style worship. Taize is a monastic community in France known for its simple repetitive songs that allow worshippers a place to settle into something familiar. We will use some familiar liturgy AND we will introduce some new meditative, repetitive songs. Each week will be the same songs and same pattern so hopefully you can come, relax and just be for a short period of time.

On both Wednesday and Sunday nights, we will be using a devotional put together by author Kate Bowler titled "Bless the Lent we Actually Have" as a way to bless the chaos, the imperfections and the hard spaces in our life. There is a daily devotional available. You can print your own copy at katebowler.com/ blessthislent or let me know and I will print a copy for you.

So dear ones, this Lent, come and bless your life as it is...chaotic and busy as it may be. And maybe, just maybe, find a moment of peace a long the way.

Elstad Lutheran Church Council Meeting Minutes Sunday January 8th, 2023 Highland Prairie Lutheran Church

The meeting was called to order by President Gene Topness at 5:41pm.

Roll call was taken. All members present. A Quorum was called.

Noisy offering raised \$1,128 and the goats and bees were doubled. The children would like to raise money again sometime this year. Exterior Sealing - Gene spoke to Tyler Clement about the sealing and Tyler said it should help. He would recommend power washing the sides of the church that have mildew before putting the seal on.

Front Steps- Gene spoke to Lance Papenfuss. He will come and take a look at it with Gene to give recommendations.

At this time we are shipping large boxes or barrels through a shipper in Indiana know to Pastor Mioche and Lyckinger Hailaire. The containers then arrive in Cap Haitian by boat. It is too dangerous to ship via Port-au-Prince at this itme and too costly to do anything significant in size or weight by plane.

Below is a list Pastor Mioche shared. School supplies are more costly this time of year so I suggest waiting to buy those in the fall. However, most of us have a drawer full of pens, pencils, crayons and markers. Used in all these categories are OK. Please sharpen pencils, and make sure all markers and pens work. If you are thinking about donating a tractor lets talk before you deliver it to the drop off site. ;)
