# Pastor's Page, September 2017

One of the great blessings of pastoral ministry is being on the receiving end of the strong witness of persons under the most difficult of conditions. I remember two words spoken by a man in the stillness of a hospital room. A note given to me before worship on Sunday morning summoned me to the hospital in a nearby city. He had lain for some days succumbing to a dread disease. I had ministered the Word and Sacrament to him many times during the siege of illness he suffered.

When I arrived at the hospital one of the nurses informed me that the man's condition had become grave. It had changed drastically during the night. He had not spoken or seemed to recognize anyone, and appeared to be non-responsive. However, I bent over to him and slowly spoke several passages from Scripture. Then, to my surprise, he spoke up in a voice, barely audible. He said, "Repeat them." In his extreme condition, this child of God did not ask for my words of comfort and assurance, but God's. It was God's word he longed to hear.

Sharing Christ's promises is the calling not only of the ordained minister. It is the calling of the every baptized man, woman, and child. We all know of persons whose life circumstances have left them without words. We all know that there are circumstances where our words seem inadequate. "Keep your chin up" just doesn't cut it. What was it that the suffering brother in Christ wanted to hear...again? The promises of our Christ. "Repeat them," he said.

Dear sisters and brothers. We are members of a community that lives to hear Christ's words addressed to us. Each and every Sunday, they are words that nourish and sustain us in the ups and downs of life and every occasion in between. Week after week they comfort us. They give rise to hope and peace. They sustain through the thick a thin of daily life in this world.

Let us continue to be the community who longs to hear the promises of God in Christ...a community who knows we need it...And refreshed and renewed in those promises, let us gladly take up our baptismal calling to be preachers sent out to "repeat" that word that we have heard for the sake of Christ and for the sake of our neighbor.

O Zion, haste, your mission high fulfilling,
To tell to all the world that God is light;
That he who made all nations is not willing
One soul should perish, lost in shades of night.
Publish glad tidings, tidings of peace,
Tidings of Jesus, redemption and release.

- 1. Call to Order at 5:40 PM
- 2. Roll Call: Members Present: Allen Skalet, Chris Hoiland, Kyle Chiglo, Joyce Dahl, Kay Dahl, Karen Bakken, Becky Halverson-Lind, Gordy Johnson and Pastor Luther Mathsen. Members Absent: Tim Stensgard and Sarah Bearbower.
- 3. Quorum Called
- 4. Allen Shared Devotions.
- 5. Approval of Agenda: Gordy asked to add an item to Old Business, item D-Scholarship Guidelines. Kay made the motion to accept the amended agenda, seconded by Chris. Motion carried.
- 6. Congregation members wishing to address the council: None
- 7. Treasurer's Report: Karen shared the Treasurer's Report via e-mail for the council to review prior to the meeting. Motion to accept the Treasurer's Report was made by Gordy, seconded by Kay. Motion carried subject to review and audit.
- 8. President's Report: None
- 9. Pastor's Report: Summer worship schedule is seeing a slight drop in summer attendance. Pastor would like to visit with the Joint Council about ideas for next summer schedule and Wednesday services. Pastor also thanked those who have helped prepare for outdoor services and events. He also mentioned he has been offering Bible Study groups and will continue. Confirmation will begin September 13<sup>th</sup> with a class of 2, possibly 4, 8<sup>th</sup> graders, no 7<sup>th</sup> graders at this point. Rally Sunday is September 10th with worship at 10 and Sunday school at 9. Monthly visits to nursing home and homebound members continue and consist of visiting, sharing of devotions and communion. Pastor stated it is as way of bringing our congregation to those members who cannot join us at church. Parish family visits continue and he will continue to do so as long as he is our Pastor. Pastor asked that we consider changing our communion to serving the wine with a serving chalice, symbolic of all drinking from one cup. ### First Call Theological Education (FCTE): What is it?

Ministry is an adventure. Like any other vocation, those who serve as clergy and deacons don't enter the field as perfect, all-knowing leaders. Instead, they are well-trained professionals who do their best to apply the knowledge they have and learn more along the way. The Southeastern Minnesota Synod provides a three-year educational and leadership development experience for new rostered ministers to empower them during their first formative years of a new call to ministry. It is called "First Call Theological Education" (FCTE).

FCTE participants gather together three times every year for three years for day-long learning experiences. They also participate in an annual retreat. The day-long gatherings and retreats are centered around six main leadership themes:

- developing a ministerial identity;
- assuming a religious leadership role and finding a balance between ministerial and personal identity;
- developing ministry skills;
- learning how to provide leadership for the variety of functions in the life of the congregation or agency being served;
- understanding one's context of ministry; and
- discovering the history, values, and commitments that shape ministry in the particular place of service.

Another component of FCTE are colleague groups. Each group meets monthly for a few hours and is facilitated by a veteran rostered minister from the synod. For Rev. Marie Anderson, who most recently served as interim pastor for Highland Prairie and Elstad Lutheran Churches, her colleague group was a major highlight of her FCTE experience: "It was valuable to meet others new to ministry and new to the synod. It meant I knew people at synod and conference events."

Over the course of several years, the relationships between participants grow and strengthen. That sense of connectedness to her colleagues remains a ministry blessing for Rev. Beth Krolak. She currently serves as pastor of Grand Meadow Lutheran Church. Rev. Krolak shared, "The colleague group was so valuable. It helped us establish lifelong connections, saw us through the loss of a beloved colleague, and for me, it set a pattern of reaching out to my colleagues."

For Rev. Charlie Leonard who now serves as pastor of Good Shepherd Lutheran Church, FCTE provided time and space to develop his ministerial identity and gain insights from peers. He valued being able to talk through day-to-day situations and then receive invaluable guidance from others: "That was the kind of advice that FCTE brought out in conversations; it doesn't happen anywhere else."

First Call Theological Education is a high priority area for the Southeastern Minnesota Synod. It supports our synod's ongoing commitment to developing leaders who are ready to follow Jesus into a changing world. Congregational mission support dollars help underwrite the costs of FCTE. Participants also pay a portion of the cost, and the congregation they serve pays the remainder. It is a shared investment between the synod, the rostered minister and the congregation. Together, we are able to support an initiative that is so much stronger than anything that we could do individually.
