At daybreak, with a cup of coffee in hand, I often shuffle off to one of my favorite spots in the parsonage, the screened-in porch. It is from there that I revel in the beauties of creation.

As I sit, gazing out on God's stunning creation, I hear birds of many kinds announcing the arrival of another day. I see beads of water on grass and green plants sparkling like diamonds in the sun. I smell the old lilac bush that casts its aroma out, carried by the breeze for anyone to enjoy.
