

COUNCIL MEETING REPORT

December 8,2024

The meeting was called to order at 11:40 p.m. by President Kyle Chiglo.Council Members present were Karen Bakken, Kyle Chiglo, Kristi Gudmundson, Mary Gudmundson, David Markegard and Mike Pepin. Robert Anfinson, Mary Gudmundson, Val Howe, and Amy Jacobson were absent. Kristi Gudmundsonwas designated as secretary in Mary Gudmundson's absence.

Pastor Jackie led everyone in prayer. A quorum was determined, and a motion to approve the agenda was made by Mike Pepin, seconded by David Markegard with the addition of Online

Giving to New Business. Motion carried No congregation members were present.

The Treasurer's Report was given by Karen Bakken. The year-to-date information provided was income of \$84,618.00, expenses of \$94,631.00; Expenses exceed income by \$10,013.00. A motion to approve as presented made by Kristi Gudmundson, Mike Pepin seconded. Motion

Pastor's Report - 28 youth received instruction for first communion. Pastor Jackie noted that plans are proceeding for a Middle School/High School Mission trip to South Dakota in July 2025. An informational meeting will be held December 8 at 2:30 p.m. at Elstad for those interested. Correspondence shared

Committee Reports:

Church – David Markegard noted that paint is peeling on some areas of the soffit and trim. **Grounds Committee –** a discussion was had regarding the continuing Box elder/Asian Beetle infestation and possible solutions. Use of spray designated as safe for indoor/outdoor use will be purchased and sprayed around foundation and windows.

Worship Committee -

Youth & Education Committee – the Christmas Program took place December 8 th . Thank you to the youth, teachers, and other helpers for offering their time and talents to bring the Christmas message to life. MS/HS Sunday School will be paused at this time because of zero attendance.

Old Business:

Constitution and Bylaws – Communication with the Synod office continues in regard to necessary steps to bring the Highland Prairie Constitution and Bylaws into compliance. **Garbage situation update** – Garbage service is now being provided by S&S Sanitation.

Parish Administrator update – There are 2 applicants for the position.

Wages need to be finalized with interviews tentatively taking place in January.

New Business:

2025 salaries (custodian, organist, treasurer) – Organist and treasurer salaries to stay the same as 2024. A motion was made by Mike Pepin to raise the custodian wages from \$13.80/hr to \$15.00/hr starting Jan. 1, 2025. David Markegard seconded. Motion carried.

Online Giving: A discussion was had regarding setting up a Church Venmo account for online giving. Karen Bakken and Pastor Jackie will investigate options.

The Secretary's report was submitted by email

A motion to adjourn with the Lord's Prayer at 1:15 p.m. was made David Markegard, Mike Pepin seconded. Motion carried.
