Dear sisters and brothers in Christ

I regard it as a blessing beyond adequate thanksgiving to have had the opportunity to serve as your pastor and be a member of this parish community of faith. You are the sixth parish God called me to serve. That he could use me as his instrument will always astound me. That I could serve among you! In this place! Such grace! Such mercy! I am humbled that such a gift has been granted to me.

Here, for the last five and a half years, Bobbi and I have enjoyed some of the best ministry years of our lives. You received us into your fellowship with grace. You provided us a grand and history-laden house in which to reside. This old farm boy, born and raised in these parts, was like a "kid in a candy store." I even had a place to park my tractor.

But the greatest blessing God has given to us has been the opportunity to be in fellowship with each and every one of you. Oh how I wish I could tell each and every one of you what a blessing you have been AND are to us. Those are blessings that will continue to be revealed to me and Bobbi in the days and years to come. We will undoubtedly look back with a dawning realization of the grace upon grace we received. That's just how it is.

A teacher of the church, Ralph C. Wood, much wiser than me, quoted another teacher, he avowed was much wiser than him. He wrote, "As St. Augustine teaches, our lives seem like a maze of chicken tracks during the living of them." That's how I am thinking about my comings and goings around this parish. I hold you all in love in my heart. I will forever be grateful for you and my time with you. I pray you will continue to live in steadfast faith, anchored in the promise of Christ, and in whose grip we all remain.
