Ask a Pastor

Welcome to the next installment of "Ask a Pastor." Please let me know if you have any questions you would like me to answer.

Why do we have weekly communion?

So admittedly this is a question I got from Highland Prairie. This question often comes with a thought that having communion so often "makes it less special" or because "we used to only have communion monthly." And it is true, throughout time, there have been a variety of practices around how often we have communion. Sometimes once a month, sometime every week, sometimes only on major festivals. Some of this change has had to to do with availability of pastors. If an ordained pastor was at a church only once a month, then those churches only had communion once a month. Other times it has been a continuation of a particular church tradition. In 1997, at the 5th Churchwide Assembly of the ELCA, the ELCA adopted a document called "The Use of the Means of Grace." This document outlines the ELCA's understanding of our sacraments and our believes around best practices with those sacraments. In this document, in the discussion around communion, the document states that "Holy Communion is celebrated weekly" because the "church needs the sacrament, the means by which the Church's fellowship is established and it's mission as the baptized people is nourished and sustained" (Use of the Means of Grace, pg 39). In short, in the ELCA, we have communion weekly because it is the place where we gather to remember we are a part of a community, where we are fed and nourished and where we receive the gift of an abundant and overflowing welcome. We have communion weekly because it is a reminder that there is space for all of us at God's table and that all are always welcome to receive God's grace. We have communion weekly because we all need God's grace and welcome every moment of our lives and this is one way we receive it.

Are we tied to the red hymnal or can we sing other hymns?

The short answer to this question is we are not "restricted" to the red hymnal. We can sing many other church hymns and more contemporary worship hymns so please let us know if you have particular suggestions.

The longer answer to this question is it hard to get outside of the red hymnal and find a way to get music to everybody. Both Highland Prairie and Elstad have copies of the "Evangelical Lutheran Worship" (ELW/Red hymnal) which means we can select songs from there and our organists have the accompaniment and the people in the pews have the music and words readily available. Also, the red hymnal gives a great starting point for selecting our weekly hymns, moving outside of that hymnal can get a bit overwhelming with all the possibilities so again, please let me know if you have any particular songs that you would like to sing in worship-whether from a hymnal or not-and we can try to make it happen!
